



STATE OF ALABAMA
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama was under imminent threat of danger from ice, snow, sleet, as well as extreme and prolonged subfreezing temperatures, and I, Robert Bentley, Governor of the State of Alabama, did declare a State of Emergency, pursuant to Code of Alabama § 31-9-8 (1975 as amended), in the State of Alabama as a result thereof; and

WHEREAS, at the request of officials at the Alabama Emergency Management Agency and after consultation with other affected parties and entities, it has been determined that a State of Emergency no longer exists in the State of Alabama.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Robert Bentley, Governor of the State of Alabama, do hereby acknowledge that the state of emergency proclaimed on January 27, 2014, as amended by Proclamation on January 29, 2014, shall hereby be terminated effective on February 3, 2014.

FURTHER, I hereby declare that the waiver issued on January 29, 2014, pursuant to 49 CFR 390.23 to facilitate a waiver to the U.S. Department of Transportation – Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, including, but not limited to, 49 CFR Section 395 (Hours of Service for Drivers) as it relates to providing emergency or disaster related materials, supplies, goods and services is hereby terminated.

BE IT ORDERED that the appropriate Alabama state agencies are hereby instructed to resume to their normal state of business and day-to-day operations.


