1 SITUATION:


A. BACKGROUND:

Black ice expected across Central Alabama tonight into Tuesday morning.

Black ice and freezing drizzle expected across Southeast Alabama and into Southwest and South Central Georgia through early Tuesday morning.

Refreezing of slushy and wet roads will create black ice and very treacherous road conditions overnight in North Alabama. Side streets and less-traveled roads will be most dangerous overnight. Patchy freezing drizzle will also leave a light glaze of ice as well, particularly in higher elevations where temperatures remain below freezing.






Ice and Snow Totals - January 9th-10th, 2010
