

## **Governor Bentley to Survey Tornado Damage in Pike County**

TROY – Governor Robert Bentley will be in Pike County Friday to visit areas affected by the December 25 severe weather outbreak. The Governor will view storm damage and visit with various officials.

The Governor's visit is scheduled to begin at the Brantley Mobile Home Park in Troy at approximately 1:45 p.m. Governor Bentley will also survey damage and visit residents along County Road 2214 starting at approximately 2:45 p.m.

Alabama Emergency Management Agency Director Art Faulkner will join Governor Bentley. The Alabama EMA is working with local emergency managers and various officials from across the state to help ensure that communities are connected to available resources.
