MEDIA ADVISORY FOR EVENT ON TUESDAY, JULY 16, 2013**

CLANTON– At the direction of Governor Bentley, The Alabama Emergency Management Agency in conjunction with several key state agencies and private partners will simulate response to a Category Three hurricane entering the Gulf. For this exercise the storm is called Hurricane Juliet. More than 170 people will have a role in this eight hour exercise. During this drill Alabama EMA will also simulate the activation of the new division offices; division A is located in Mobile and includes the surrounding counties and division B is located in Troy and it includes the surrounding counties in that area.
