Alabama Emergency Management Agency Monitors Possible Winter Weather Precipitation, Urges Residents to be Prepared

Clanton-Alabama Emergency Management Agency Director Art Faulkner briefed Governor Bentley on the possibility of winter weather precipitation that may impact parts of Alabama late Sunday night into Monday.

All primary state agencies have been notified and their emergency management coordinators are on standby for the potential activation of the emergency operation center in Clanton.

The Alabama Emergency Management Agency is in contact with the National Weather Service and will be monitoring this weather event until the threat diminishes. AEMA is on standby to coordinate resources to support the needs of the counties if necessary.

During the forecasted period it is important for residents to stay aware of weather conditions as temperatures are expected to fall below freezing in many locations across Central and Northern Alabama. Residents are also encourage to make sure they are prepared.
